## FOR THE YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2018

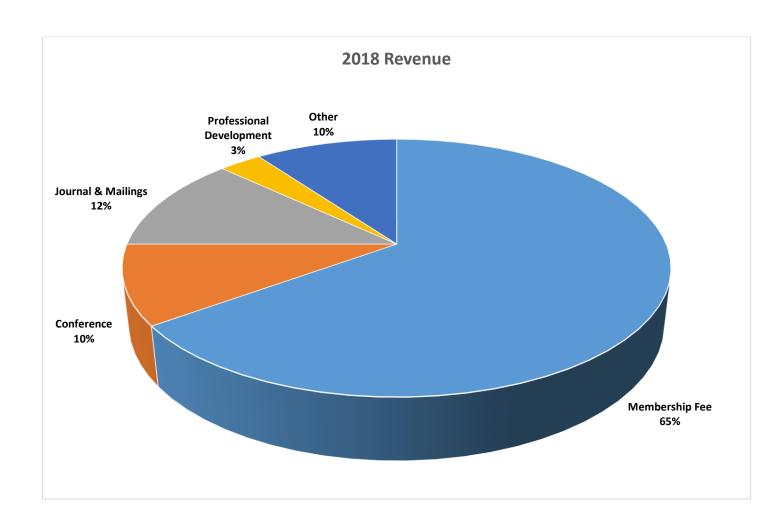

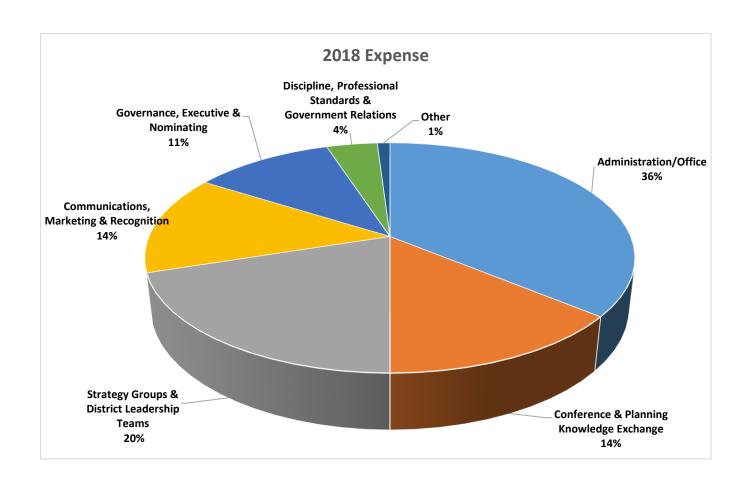
